

HOW TO COME TO SERRES FROM THE AIRPORT OF ATHENS

If you arrive at the airport of Athens, you can come to Serres by train or by bus. For further information about access to the airport of Athens [click here](#).

A) GOING FROM ATHENS TO SERRES BY TRAIN

1. Going to the train station

Athens has two train stations. The trains to northern Greece depart from the station called "Stathmos Larissis".

You can get to Stathmos Larissis by metro.

- Take the metro line and get off at Syntagma (BE CAREFUL, DO NOT TAKE THE SUBURBAN TRAIN – in greek "Proastiakos").
- Change to line 2, direction "Agios Antonios", and get off at "Stathmos Larissis".

The cost of the ticket (one-way) is 8 euro. It is a combined ticket and gives the right to change to another line of metro (within 90 min.). So, you do not need to buy a second ticket in order to change to line 2.

You can take a group ticket for 2 or 3 persons, which costs 14 or 20 euro, respectively.

2. Taking the train to Serres (or to Thessaloniki)

You can take a train either to Serres or to Thessaloniki (and then take the bus to Serres).

You can make a reservation and buy the tickets online.

The cost of tickets varies. The earlier you buy a ticket, the cheaper it will be. You can buy tickets for 9 euro for the leg Athens – Thessaloniki and 5.5 euro for the leg Thessaloniki – Serres.

You must change trains in Thessaloniki. The whole journey will take about 8-9 hours.

3. Arriving at the train station in Serres

The train station is located at the edge of the town.

We will come to take you from the train station - or otherwise you will take a taxi. It will cost you about 5 euro to go to the town or to the University.

4. Taking the train Athens – Thessaloniki & then going to Serres

You can go to Thessaloniki by train and then take the bus to go to Serres (Keep in mind that the last bus to Serres is at 21:30 or 22:00).

- Take bus 8, 45A, 45B and 78 from the train station of Thessaloniki to the bus station ("KTEL Makedonia").

A ticket costs 0,80. You can buy a ticket on board, from an automatic machine (the ticket then cost 0.90 and the machine does not return change). BE CAREFUL to take direction to "KTEL Makedonia".

- Find the station to Serres. Buses depart practically every half an hour (e.g. 9:00, 9:30, 10:00, etc.). Tickets cost 8,20 euro. You must buy your ticket before entering the bus.

B) GOING FROM ATHENS TO SERRES BY BUS

The bus station in Athens is called “Kifissos Station”.

1. Going to “Kifissos bus station” from the airport

Take Bus X93, “Kifissos Coach Station – Airport”

2. Taking a bus from Athens to Serres

Find the station to Serres.

Departures: 13:15, 15:00 & 22:00.

The trip takes about 7 hours.

Cost: 45 euro.

3. Taking a bus from Athens to Thessaloniki and then changing to Serres Serres

Another option is to take the bus to Thessaloniki and then change to another bus to Serres.

It will cost you more money, but the service to Thessaloniki is more frequent than direct lines to Serres. For example, there are buses that depart at: 07:00 - 08:00 - 10:00 - 12:00 - 13:30 - 15:00 - 16:30 - 18:00 - 19:30 - 21:30* - 23:00 - 24:00.

The buses depart from Kifissos Station, as well.

A ticket costs 42 euro (and another 8,20 from Thessaloniki to Serres).

4. Arriving at the bus station in Serres

We will try to come and take you from the train or the bus station. Otherwise, take a taxi. It will cost you about 5 euro to go to the town or the University.
