

HOW TO COME TO SERRES FROM THE AIRPORT OF THESSALONIKI

The best way to come to Serres from the airport of Thessaloniki is by bus. Serres is also connected to Thessaloniki by train, but the service is not very frequent.

1. Going to the bus station (“KTEL Makedonia”)

The bus stop is across the road of the exit of the airport.

Take bus No 78 (avoid bus 78A, which provides another route that needs to change to a connecting line).

Bus No 78 departs practically every half an hour. For example:

13:00`	13:30`
14:00`	14:45`
15:15`	15:45`
16:30`	
17:00`	17:30`
18:00`	18:30`

A ticket costs 0.80 (if you buy it from the ticket booth, located next to the bus station).

It costs 0.90, if you buy it on board.

2. Arriving at “KTEL Makedonia”

Get off at the terminal station, called “KTEL Makedonia” (KTEL nearly means “bus station”).

It will normally take about 1 hour to get there.

BE CAREFUL: the bus goes by the Train Station first and it is possible to make the mistake to believe it is the bus station.

3. Taking the bus from Thessaloniki to Serres

“KTEL Makedonia” is a big bus terminal that accommodates almost all the bus lines departing from Thessaloniki.

Go to the station of the buses departing to Serres.

The departures are very frequent, practically every 30 min during daytime.

Buy the ticket before entering the bus.

A ticket costs 8,20 euro.

The route to Serres takes about 1:15.

4. Arriving at the bus station in Serres

We will try to come and take you from the train or the bus station. Otherwise, take a taxi. It will cost you about 5 euro to go to the town or the University.
